Who being sworn and charged to answer of and
concerning divers Articles recognizable in this Court present as follows (sworn)

The Homage aforesaid present as follows

In the first place They present and Answer every Tenant belonging to
this Manner who did not appear or Esqure at this Court being Duly
Summoned five Shillings each to be paid to the Lord of this Manner
also - They present that none of the Inhabitants of this Manner shall put
any Turf or Peat in any of the Commons within this Manner without
the Licence from the Lord thereof under the Penalty of five pounds
a Cart Load and a proportionable Sume for every Wheelbarrow full or any
other Quantity conveyed in what manner soever either more or less than
a Load to be paid to the said Lord and the like Penalty upon those
that carry the same away

Also present that no person in this Manner shall put any fence
in any of the Commons of this Manner to be burnt out of the Parish
or in any Kine within this Parish under the Penalty of Twenty
Shillings each Load and so in proportion for any greater or less
Quantity to be paid by the person who puts the same to the said
Lord and the like on those who carry the same away

also - Will present Gabriel Fidler and Edward Fidler for cutting at least
one Log of timber in the Execution of this Charter and burning the same
in a Tilting-bowm contrary to an Order made at the last Court held for
this Manner.

also - Will present that none of the Inhabitants within this Manner
shall Justice any of the Waste or Commonable Land within this
Manner without Licence of the said Lord on penalty of Twenty
Shillings per pole to be paid to the said Lord ~

also - Will present that ~~any~~ person shall put any Stone Work into the Commons
or any Woods Infected with the Mango or any other Infection
Diseas per under the penalty of Twenty Shillings to be paid to the
said Lord ~

also - Will present that ~~any~~ person shall digg Land to carry out of this
Manner under the penalty of Twenty Shillings each Load to be paid
to the said Lord ~

also - Will present Gabriel Fidler for erecting a Cottage on the Lord's
Waste within this Manner and order him to pull the same downe off
or before Michaelmas next under the penalty of five pounds to be paid
to the said Lord ~

also - Will present William Buckridge for erecting a Cottage on the
Lord's Waste within this Manner and order him to pull the same downe
on or before Michaelmas next under the penalty of five pounds to be
paid to the said Lord ~

also - Will chst James Knight Wayward for this Manner for this year
ensuing and order for his Wages Sixpence each Cow or Ox, One
Shilling a Stone or more for Sheep that he shall pound belonging
to this Manner and Double the penaltys above for such Cattle that
he shall impound belonging to any person that is not an inhabitant
