October our thousand four hundred thirty eight I Thomas Winton of Winton in the County  
of Wilton a common burgess, whole in body and of good and quiet memory pray God to  
make and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form followinge viz. First I commend  
my soule unto Almyghty god my maker and fardoun. I praye and sturdfastlie becomynge I praye  
to be receyved into the haven of life and possession of his sount Jesus Christ to be ptaker of his heavenly kyngdom and  
my body to be buried in the church yards of St. Peter and St. Pauls neere unto the place wher  
funt my wyfe was buried. And remitteth the same to John & his heires and bequeath unto my  
sonne Hugh (the sonne of my first wyfe) the sum of five shyllings and also my tenement with the garden in the  
all the termes and times in and by the lease by my selfe made and bequeath unto  
my sonne Edward the said sum of five shyllings and also my tenement with the garden in the  
by virtue of the six said bonds or specialties herin formen expressed viz. first of Thomas  
the sixteenth sucetie the bond of Thomas William and Mosed Winton the second of Edward  
and Euan the sixth sucetie the bond of Thomas Glover the sixth sucetie the sixth of William  
Edward the sixth sucetie and the sixth of William Martine the sixth sucetie together with the said  
said specialties and the interest and sume of money due unto me for the forebarant  
of the said tenement John & his heires and bequeath unto my said sonne Edward the said sume  
due unto me by bond of John Duxton together with the said bond or specialty and all the  
interest due by virtue of the said bond John & his heires and bequeath unto my said sonne  
said sonne Edward the said sume beinge my owne propre goods and beinge in the bestokid of my  
said sonne Edward to be paid unto him by the said Edward his flathe at the end of three years  
next ensuinge the date hereof. Item I give devise and bequeath unto my sonne Edward the  
debt by bond the one of William Fogge of Moleton with sucetie and the other of William North  
the sixth sucetie together with the said bonds and all interest or sume of money due by virtue of any of  
the said tenement John & his heires and bequeath unto my said sonne Edward the said sume  
unto my daughter Marye her debt due by bond the one of Margueryt White foote videlicet the  
said specialties and the other now in the hands of the said sonne together with the said bond and  
all interest and sume of money due by virtue of the said bonds. Item I give and bequeath unto my  
sonne John the said sume one debt due by bond of Edward Lloyd with out sucetie together with the said bond  
and all the interest and sume of money due for the forebarant thereof by virtue of the said  
bond. Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Margeret daughter John Duxton and debt due  
by bond of John Duxton together with the said bond and the interest and sume of money due  
for the forebarant thereof by virtue of the said bond. Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter  
Wesula her debt due by bond of Thomas Gauder the sixth sucetie together with the said  
bond and all interest due by virtue thereof and one brace of gain and tulle hord in the call  
I give and bequeath unto the daughter of William Skelton by my said daughter Wesula  
one part of the said bond and one half of the said bond and one half of the said bond. Item I give and  
bequeath unto my daughter Junia her debt due by bond the one of Edward Wilefoote with  
sucetie and the other of William William the sixth sucetie together with the said bonds and all interest  
and sume and sume of money due by virtue of the said bonds together and all mairtains remittynge  
unto Abraham John and Thomas her three sonnes the sume of eight poundes viz. four shyllings  
apiece to be paid unto them out of the said debts and bonds. And my will is that her said three  
sonnes and the benefitt of the interest of the said eight poundes be paid from the day of the date of this
